- **Each article shown must be the work of the exhibitor.**
- **Entries limited to three entries per exhibitor per class.**
- Any item designed to be hung must be equipped with a wire hanger. No sawtooth hangers.
- **NO SOILED, WORN OR UNFINISHED ARTICLE, OR ANY ARTICLE THAT HAS BEEN SHOWN PREVIOUSLY WILL BE CONSIDERED.**
- New work is given preference, and no article considered unworthy by the judge will be given a premium.
- **Judge's decision is final.**
- This department is **NOT** for professionals.
- **NO PROFESSIONALS ALLOWED.** A **PROFESSIONAL** is a person following an occupation as a means of livelihood or for gain.
